



2017-2018 OEE COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

The Ohio State University is dedicated to advancing education, research and innovation related to energy, the environment and sustainability. To further these goals, the Office of Energy and Environment Commitment to Sustainability Scholarship is intended to support full-time undergraduate students interested in studying energy, environment and sustainability-related issues at Ohio State. Priority will be given to undergraduate students with a strong academic background and proven record of collegiate, community and/or civic engagement, as well as those who demonstrate collaboration, teambuilding, and teamwork. OEE anticipates making up to five (5) awards of up to \$1,000 each (\$5,000 total) each academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Undergraduate students from any OSU college, department or academic unit may apply. To be eligible, students must be fulltime, undergraduate, degree-seeking students in good academic standing within their respective college, department or academic unit, and have a 3.2 minimum grade-point average. They must read and understand the fact sheet and application. They must agree to terms outlined in the award letter. Previous award recipients and employees of the Office of Energy and Environment are not eligible to apply.

APPLICATION

As part of the selection process, selectors may consider the student's creativity, academic performance and potential, major and minor courses of study, academic and career goals, as well as collegiate, civic and community engagement.

In order to be considered to receive funding, students must submit the following:

- A completed application form
- Unofficial academic advising report
- A one (1) page resume or curriculum vitae
- A one (1) page recommendation letter from OSU faculty, staff, or an external contact highlighting the student's interest and commitment to energy, environment, and sustainability goals
- A two (2) page personal statement describing the student's: (a) interest in energy, environment, and sustainability; (b) academic background, goals and expected graduation date; (c) career plans, including how this scholarship would help the student achieve those objectives; and (d) plans or contributions to creating awareness of or lasting changes in energy, environment, and sustainability.

DEADLINES

Applications must be submitted by email at OEEStudentPrograms@osu.edu no later than **11:59PM on Sunday, November 19**. Awards will be announced no later than **December 8**. Funds will be posted to awardees bursar accounts by **January 3**.
